



COCHISE COUNTY SELECTS RAPID-TRACE FOR CONTACT TRACING

Rapid-Trace is partnering with Cochise County AZ Health and Social Services Department to support contact tracing protocols within the county.

Rapid-Trace specializes in contact tracing services for academia, corporations, and government entities. Contact tracers at Rapid-Trace have all completed the Johns Hopkins COVID-19 Contact Tracing course and are trained on adherence to CDC guidelines, HIPAA rules and procedures, local policies, cybersecurity, and data management. Rapid-Trace observes strict protocol regarding confidentiality and data security.

“Rapid-Trace is singularly focused on mitigating the spread of COVID-19 in the community. We are proud to be a supporting partner to Cochise County Health as it deals with the Pandemic effects in the county.” said Chelsea Perez-Shircel, Contact Tracing Manager at Rapid-Trace.

In collaborating with Cochise County Health and Social Services Department, Rapid-Trace guides COVID-positive individuals to appropriate health resources and isolation and swiftly notifies contacts in order to assist with their symptom reporting and self-quarantine. Rapid-Trace works closely with Cochise County Public Health officials to provide contacts with support for testing, vaccinating, and medical care, if needed.

Partnering with Rapid-Trace will augment the ongoing efforts of Cochise County to assist its citizens to mitigate the local spread of COVID-19.

In describing the partnership, Martha Montaña, an epidemiologist at the Health and Social Services Department, said, “By far, adding Rapid-Trace as part of our COVID-19 Investigation Team has been one of the best decisions we’ve made in fighting the virus in our community.
